

Emirate of Fujairah



The United Arab Emirates was formed in 1971 and is comprised of seven emirates. Fujairah, one of these emirates, is located on the East Coast on the Indian Ocean. It is the only emirate that is situated on the beautiful Indian Ocean and therefore attracts many tourists. To the west of Fujairah are the breathtaking Hajar Mountains. The Hajar Mountains are the highest mountain range in the eastern Arabian Peninsula and run through both the UAE and Oman, peaking at 2,980m high. The entire emirate of Fujairah is 1,488 square kilometres and is made up of 2 main cities (Fujairah and Dibba Al Fujairah) and six main areas (Masafi, Murbeh, Qidfa, Al Bithna, Al Siji, Al Bidyah). Fujairah is the smallest in Emirates, it is the only region that lies on the Indian Ocean. For this reason, it has become a very popular vacation site for many residents and attract a lot of tourist. The beaches in Fujairah stretch on for miles of uninterrupted serenity. With beautiful clam waters and quiet beaches, people from all over flock come there to relax in the sun and sand.

Fujairah is located on the eastern coast of the UAE along the Gulf of Oman. The shores of Fujairah extend along the Gulf of Oman for about 70km. Fujairah is the only emirates of the UAE that is almost completely mountainous than other part of UAE which are deserts. Fujairah are well known for its beaches and the Hajar Mountains, which run through much of the emirate. In the south, the city of Fujairah is home to the massive Sheikh Zayed Mosque, with its towering white minarets. Overlooking the city is Fujairah Fort, a reconstructed 17th-century fortress featuring round and square towers. Consequently, Fujairah are the only area that receive high average of yearly rainfall in the UAE and this allows the farmers in that region to produce crop every year. Fujairah has been called An Arabian Jewel, the Hidden Gem and the quaint getaway of the UAE but Lately, His Highness, Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum called Fujairah 'the lungs of the UAE'.

Airport

The official arrival airport is the Dubai International Airport (Terminal - 3). The Organizing Committee will pick you up at the airport on the Official Arrival Day on Nov. 06th, 2019 (Wednesday) and drive you to the official hotel and back to the Dubai International Airport (Terminal - 3) on the official Departure Day (Sunday) for EUR €40 (USD \$45) two way per person. On November 6th buses will leave from the airport to the hotel every hour from (0:00) till the last flight arrival.

It is very important that every National Federation provides to the Organizing Committee the complete information on its team, including the number of persons and the arrival/departure details in time. Your cooperation is essential to ensure adequate transportation for your team.

Early arrivals & late departures: any National Federation, including any of its individual team members, arriving before the official arrival date of November 6th and/or staying after the official departure date of November 10th, 2019 will be responsible for all of their expenses, including arranging their own transportation between the airport and the hotel. You must notify the Organizing Committee of any early arrivals or late departures.

Accommodations

The Organizing Committee will provide free-of-charge accommodations for four (4) nights and three (3) meals per day for all official participants (athletes & delegates) from National Federations according to the following IFBB rules:

- · Three or more competitors: two delegates permitted.
- Two competitors or less: only one delegate is permitted.

National Federations with no competitors may send one (1) delegate who will be responsible for all of his or her own expenses. The term "Official Participant" means:

- 1) An Athlete who is duly authorized by his National Federation and who is registered by the IFBB to compete in the Championships.
- 2) A Delegate who is duly authorized by his National Federation and who is registered by the IFBB to participate in the Championships pursuant to the IFBB Rules.

Official arrival date is November 6th, 2019 (Wednesday) and the official departure date is November 10th, 2019 (Sunday). IFBB Executive Council Members: official arrival date is November 5th ,2019 (Tuesday) and the official departure date is November 10th, 2019 (Sunday).

IMPORTANT NOTICE

All National Team Official Participants (athletes and delegates) must check in BEFORE the start of the Technical Meeting. Any Official Participant not checked in by this deadline will be classified as an extra delegate and will be responsible for all his/her expenses.

Any judge, coach, or trainer who is not an Official Participant will be responsible for all his expenses. If your National Federation wishes to bring a judge, a coach or a trainer, it is recommended that your Federation nominates this individual to be an Official participant for your Federation; otherwise, these individuals will be responsible for all their own expenses. The same rule applies for family members.

NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.



Hotel

A hotel security deposit of USD \$100 per person is required upon check-in for incidental and personal expenses that may arise (telephone, mini-bar, laundry, damages of room etc.). The unused portion of this deposit will be refunded at check-out in the same currency as remitted.

In order to facilitate matters, the chief delegate or team leader will be asked to provide a credit card or cash to cover the deposit for the entire team. This individual will be fully responsible for all expenses incurred by any member of his/her team.











Important Notice

You must pay the Hotel Security Deposit and IFBB Registration Fee BEFORE your team members are provided accommodations. If any of your athletes or delegates arrives to FUJAIRAH without their Team Manager or Chief Delegate, that athlete or delegate must pay the Hotel Security Deposit and the IFBB Registration Fee BEFORE a room can be assigned.

Participation

The IFBB World Men's Championships are open to all IFBB-affiliated National Federations worldwide. Competitors must be current members of their IFBB-affiliated National Federation at the time of competition to be eligible. The number of competitors participating in the Championships is unlimited.

Please be aware that it is FULL RESPONSIBILITY AND OBLIGATION OF THE NATIONAL FEDERATION to verify if each one of the athletes to be registered on this international event are NOT suspended or fulfilling any period of ineligibility due to Anti-Doping Rule Violation or any disciplinary case at national or international level.

It is also the **FULL OBLIGATION AND RESPONSIBILITY** of a National Federation to MONITOR ALL THE ATHLETES affiliated to this National Federation who are actually fulfilling a period of ineligibility due to Anti-Doping Rule Violation or any Disciplinary case, to make sure these athletes WILL NOT REGISTER/COMPETE OR PARTICIPATE IN ANY CAPACITY in any event either at National or International level, Official or Invitational.

OFFICIAL ATHLETE REGISTRATION

Official Athlete Registration will be run on Thursday, November 07th, from 15:00 till 19:00 hrs at the Zayed Sport Complex.

It is the responsibility of the chief delegate or team leader to make sure that the athletes are on time. Any athletes who are late will not be accepted to participate.

All athletes will have to produce their Passports and IFBB International Cards at the Registration. IFBB International Cards are EUR €35 per year and are mandatory. Any athlete who has not yet purchased this Card will have to buy one at Registration.

PLEASE NOTE: No crossovers between different sport divisions are allowed i.e. not possible to compete in both Bodybuilding and Classic Bodybuilding or Classic Physique.











IFBB Registration And Accommodation

Hotel check-in and accommodation will take place at the *HOTELNOVOTELFU]AIRA.H*, Hamad Bin Abdulla Rd - Fujairah, Wednesday, November 6th, from 10:00 till 19:00 h.

Official Athlete Registration (weigh-in) will be conducted on Wednesday 6th November at Novotel Hotel from 15:00 till 19:00 and on Thursday, November 7th, from 15:00 till 19:00 at the Zayed Sports Complex. It is the responsibility of the chiefdelegate or team leader to make sure that the athletes are on time. Any athletes who are late will not be accepted to participate.

All athletes will have to produce their Passports and IFBB International Cards at the Registration.

Crossovers (participation in two categories) will not be possible. Posing music must be on an audio CD and USB Flach Memory only. The posing music must also be at the start of the CD or USB. Each competitor must affix his name on the CD or USB for easy identification. The use of profane, vulgar and offensive language is strictly prohibited in the posing music.

Each athlete participating in the event will be provided with a competitor wristband at the Registration. This wristband allows daily admission to the venue and should not be removed.

Awards

- Top three athletes in each category will be awarded with IFBB medals.
- Top six athletes in each category will be awarded with Certificates of Excellence.
- Overall in each division will have a trophy.
- Top 10 in each category will be awarded with points to the 2019 IFBB World Ranking.
- Each Overall category winner will receive additional 5 points to the 2019 IFBB World Ranking
- Each category winner will have a right to apply to turn IFBB Elite Pro (through their National Federations).

Note:

All national teams are required to submit softcopy of Flag and National Anthem in CD File or Flash Drive to the Organizing Committee or IFBB O%cial during the registration for the purpose of flag display and rendering of National Anthem in the screen monitor during the event.











Judges And Delegates Meeting

There will be a Team Managers and Judges Meeting prior to the official athlete registration (weigh-in) on Thursday, November 7th at 14:00 hrs. All Judges must attend the Team Managers & Judges Meeting and Delegates will be obliged to attend this meeting.



Secretariat

The Organizing Committee will manage a Secretariat at the official hotel from Tuesday November 5th, until Sunday, November 10th, from 08:00 till 20:00. You may obtain information and assistance from the Secretariat.



Parade Of Nations

The mandatory dress code for all delegates participating in the Parade of Nations (one delegate per country) will be IFBB attire, black dress shoes, grey dress pants with shirt, IFBB tie and blue blazer with the IFBB crest. No delegates will be permitted in the Parade of Nations wearing sports clothes and sports shoes.

Camera / Video Tape Equipment

Cameras and/or video tape equipment shall be strictly prohibited in the backstage and/or dressing room areas except when used by the IFBB authorized media person and, in any event, these devices shall be strictly prohibited in the dressing room area.

Note: Tanning Available With The Organizing Committee

The IFBB has banned all tans that can be wiped off. An official will check the tan of all athletes backstage and if the tan comes off by simply wiping, the athlete will be told to remove the tan before going on stage. • Approved Tan available with the Organizing Committee before competition.

Green Cards

Green cards are used to limit access to the weigh-in and backstage area during the prejudging & finals. They will be distributed at the Team Managers and Judges Meeting as follows:

• Five (5) or more athletes – two (2) green cards. • Less than (5) athletes – one (1) green card.











Judges

To be taken into consideration during selection ofjudges panels at the competition, IFBB International Judges (as well as test-judges) must be included in the Final Entry Forms sent by National Feaerations, accordin_g to the IFBB Rules. All judges who wish to be included in the judges' panels at these Championships should be specified in the Final Entry Form. The test judges should be specified there as well.

Judges have to pay the yearly Judges' License fee of EUR €50 for 2019. This fee may be paid at the Championships. Test judges should pay a test fee of EUR €50. This fee may be paid at the Championships.

All judges must attend the Judges/Team Managers & Judges Meeting.

If the above conditions haven't been met, judges will not be able to carry out their duties at the Championships.









Doping Control

Doping control will be conducted by the IFBB Anti-Doping Commission pursuant to the IFBB Anti-Doping rules, using a WADA accredited laboratory. In order to compete in the championships, all competitors at the weigh-in and registration will be required to sign a Drug Testing Consent & Waiver of Liability Form. Doping control may be conducted using any of the following methods:

- · Random Selection: A number of athletes selected at random throughout the event e.g. at weigh-in.
- Weighted Selection: A number of athletes selected at random from among the top finalists e.g. at finals.

The IFBB reserves the rights to target test any athlete.

The IFBB is a signatory to the WADA Code. Participating National Federations have a duty and an obligation to ensure that their national team athletes are competing drug-free at IFBB international competitions.



Visa

Please contact the United Arab Emirates Embassy in your country to determine if you need a visa.

It is National Federations responsibility to obtain an entry visa for the country organizing the championship. All National Federations could ask for an Invitation letter either to the Championship Organizer or IFBB. The invitation letter does not mean you are granted your visa. IFBB and Championship organizer are not responsible of attendant's visas.

To receive invitation letter, the applicant should forward the following information to the IFBB or Championship organizer:

- · A copy of Passport
- · Where the attendant will have his or her accommodation

If the visa is not granted, the Cancellation Policies for the championship will still apply.

An athlete, who requested and received an invitation from the IFBB Head Office or the Organizing Committee of an IFBB sanctioned event for visa purposes and used this visa to unlawful stay in the host country or any other country, will be subjected to the disciplinary proceedings and measures.

Attendance at the IFBB International Congress

It is the duty and responsibility of each National Federation to ensure that it is represented at the IFBB International Congress meeting. All National Federations officially participating in the championships must also attend the Congress, including National Federations with athletes and no delegates. In this case the athlete must attend and represent his country at the Congress. The Congress will be held at: ZAYED SPORTS COMPLEX on Thursday, Nov 7th, 2019 at 08:30 hrs.



Athletes Without Delegates

All athletes competing at the IFBB World Championships must be members in good standing of their National Federations. Any athlete who arrives without a delegate must be nominated by his National Federation by sending the Final Entry Form, failing which the athlete will not be allowed to participate.



Misrepresentation

Misrepresentation is a serious breach of the IFBB CODE OF ETHICS and occurs when an "official" of a National Federation deliberately misrepresents the number of athletes and delegates so as to obtain free of charge accommodations, meals, onsite transportation, access to the prejudging, finals, and farewell banquet, and other amenities at the expense of the Organizer. Part of this misrepresentation may be a false claim that a person is an athlete only to have that so-called athlete fail to officially register as a competitor at the weigh-in or, once having officially registered, fail to compete. Any National Federation found guilty of misrepresentation will be immediately disqualified from the championships and will be fined an amount equal to the Special Package Rate for each person involved.



Medical Withdrawal

Once officially registered, no athlete may withdraw from competition without the prior approval of the IFBB Chief Judge. It is not accepted for a national federation to unilaterally withdraw an athlete without prior approval of the IFBB chief judge, who has the right to verify the reason for the withdrawal.



Preliminary Entry Form (PEF)

The deadline for the Preliminary Entry Form (available in the Appendix) is September 7th, 2019. National Federations must return the Preliminary Entry Form to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible but not later than deadline, confirming your federation's intent to participate. If at this time you do not know the actual names of the Official Participants (athletes and delegates, including judges), please indicate the total number of individuals from your National Federation who will participate in the Championships.



Final Entry Form (FEF)

The deadline for the Final Entry Form is Monday, October 21st, 2019. National Federations must submit the actual names of all Official Participants (athletes by discipline and category, Delegates, including judges). You must also include arrival and departure information. In order to guarantee hotel accommodations for your team, the Final Entry Form must be returned not later than the deadline. Your cooperation is essential to ensuring your accommodations at the hotel and adequate transportation for your team.

IF THE FINAL ENTRY FORM RETURNS TO THE ORGANIZING COMMITTEE AFTER OCTOBER 21st, 2019 THEN THIS NATIONAL FEDERATIONWILL HAVE TO PAY THEFULL PACKAGEIN A DOUBLE ROOM OR IN A SINGLE ROOM FOR EACH MEMBER OF ITS NATIONAL TEAM (ATHLETES AND DELEGATES).
