Language:

Tahitian, a dialect of Mainland Island, is spoken by 70% of people in Tahiti however French is also widely spoken and is the language of preference in the government, business and tourism sectors. As a visitor, you can expect to encounter minimal problems communicating in English, as most taxi drivers, salespeople, tourism industry employees and police have reached competent levels of the language. Also, all official signs and public transport announcements, as well as most menus, are in both French and English.

Climate:

With a tropical climate, French Polynesia enjoys a good sunshine throughout the year. The IFBB South Pacific & Oceania Championships 2019 will take place in summer (April to October). Expect hot, humid and sunny weather with occasional showers. Average temperature is 22°C-30°C, with high humidity. Tahiti Faa'a International Airport:

Tahiti-Faa'a International Airport is located in Faaa on the island of Tahiti in French Polynesia, 5 km from Papeete, 20 minutes by taxi to the « Tahiti Pearl Beach Resort ». It serves as a connecting platform for Air France, Air Tahiti Nui, Aircalin, Lan Airlines, Hawaiian Airlines, Air New Zealand, French Bee, United Airlines and Air Tahiti. It is classified as a state aerodrome.

Tahiti is a key aviation hub serviced by more than 10 airlines that provide connections to major cities throughout the world. The Tahiti Faa'a International Airport is a 24-hour airport, which is consistently ranked among the safest airports in the world.

Participation:

The 2019 IFBB South Pacific & Oceania Championships is open to IFBB-affiliated South Pacific & Oceania National Federations. Competitors must be current members of their IFBB-affiliated National Federation at the time of competition to be eligible. IFBB National Federations are informed that participation in this Championship is unlimited.

To participate in this competition, athletes must be nominated by their IFBB-affiliated federations. To be nominated, you must do the following:

- Contact your IFBB-affiliated National Federation and declare you would like to participate in the 2019 IFBB South Pacific & Oceania Championships.
- National Federations approve the list of competitors from their countries, completes the Final Entry Form and e-mails it to the IFBB Tahiti Head Office: ifbbtahiti.secretary@gmail.com and ifbb.tahiti@gmail.com with a copy to the IFBB Technical Committee and IFBB Head Office in Madrid not later than September 20th, 2019.
- After being approved by your National Federation, you need to pay the IFBB
 Registration Fee of USD \$100. This will have to be paid at the time of the
 Official Registration in Tahiti or in advance. We fully recommend you to make
 advance payment by PayPal or Credit Card through the following link:

Crossovers: If an athlete wants to participate in the second category (like a master or junior in the senior open class also), the registration fee for this second category is **USD \$50**.

Please be aware that it is FULL RESPONSIBILITY AND OBLIGATION OF THE NATIONAL FEDERATION to verify if each one of the athletes to be registered in this international event are NOT suspended or fulfilling any period of ineligibility due to Anti-Doping Rule Violation or any disciplinary case at national or international

level.

The deadline date for submitting the Final Entry Forms is **Friday, September 20**th, **2019**. The final decision to allow an athlete to compete in this event rests with the IFBB.

Competitor Notification:

Competitors officially nominated by National Federations in the Final Entry Forms are considered as approved. If, for any reason, a competitor has not been approved by the IFBB, his/her National Federation will be notified that he/she will be unable to participate in this competition.

We strongly encourage you to register early and make the appropriate arrangements to compete.

Official Athlete Registration (Weigh-In) and Fee:

The official arrival day for all National Teams is Friday, October 04th, 2019.

Registration, weigh-in and height measurements will take place at « **Tahiti Pearl Beach Resort** » **on Friday, October 04**th, **2019 from 17:30 till 19:30 hrs.**

At the registration, weigh-in, you will be asked to produce:

- ID Document
- IFBB International Card (Blue Book)
- Posing music on audio CD or USB (if posing is required in your division
- Official attire to each round, including shoes (women athletes)

Any athlete who has not yet purchased or renewed his/her IFBB International Card will have to do so at Registration. The cost is EUR €35 (USD \$45) per calendar year. IFBB International Cards are mandatory.

As mentioned above, the **IFBB Registration Fee of USD \$100** per participant will have to be paid in advance online or at the Registration. We fully recommend you to make advance payment at www.ifbb-tahiti.com

Please add your name during online payment and bring a copy of your payment confirmation to the Championships.

If you have not paid before the Championships, you will have to pay these fees upon arrival at the Official CHECK-POINT in the « Tahiti Pearl Beach Resort ». The IFBB Registration Fees is completely separate from the hotel security deposit.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

You must pay the hotel security deposit of USD \$50 per person and the IFBB Registration Fee **BEFORE** your Team members are provided accommodations. If

any of your athletes or delegates arrives to Tahiti without their Team Manager or Chief Delegate, that athlete or delegate must pay the hotel security deposit and IFBB Registration Fee **BEFORE** a room can be assigned.

Important Information:

All the costs for the hotel accommodations, transport from and to the airport and 3 meals per day for Official Participants* are free of charge for 2 days and nights from the official arrival date, Friday, October 04th, 2019 to the official departure date, Sunday, October 06th, 2019 for all officials delegations, according to the IFBB Rules:

*The term "Official Participant" means 1) an Athlete who is duly authorized by his or her National Federation and who is registered by the IFBB to compete in the Championships, and 2) a Delegate who is duly authorized by his or her National Federation and who is registered by the IFBB to participate in the Championships pursuant to IFBB Rules:

Three (3) or more competitors = two (2) delegates; Two (2) competitors or less = one (1) delegate

A National Federation with no athlete may send (1) delegate; however, this delegate will be responsible for all his or her expenses.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

All National Team Official Participants (athletes and delegates) must check-in BEFORE the start of Technical Meeting (October 04th at 16:00 hrs). Any Official Participant not checked-in by this deadline, without notifying the Organizing Committee, will be classified as an extra delegate and will be responsible for all his or her expenses. Any judges, coaches or trainers who are not an Official Participant will be responsible for all his or her own expenses. If your National Federation wishes to bring a judge, coach or trainer, it is recommended that your Federation nominate this individual to be an Official Participant for your Federation; otherwise, these individuals will be responsible for all their own expenses. The same rule applies for family members.

Athletes without delegate:

All athletes competing at these Championships must be Members in Good Standing of their National Federations. All athletes arriving without a Delegate must be nominated by their National Federation by sending the Final Entry Form with their names., failing which the Athletes will not be allowed to participate.

Failure to honor the Final Entry Form deadline:

Deadlines are set to assist the Organizer with arranging accommodations, meals, onsite transportation and other Championships activities. A failure to respect

these deadlines is breach of IFBB Rules.

If a National Federation fails to respect the deadlines written on the Final Entry Form, each « Official Participant » from that Federation will be required to pay all of his or her own expenses, including accommodation, meals, onsite transportation, and access to the Pre-judging, Finals and Farewell Banquet.

Misrepresentation:

Misrepresentation is a serious breach of the IFBB Code of Ethics and occurs when an « official » of a National Federation deliberately misrepresents the numbers of Athletes and Delegates, so as to obtain free-of-charge accommodations, meals on site transportation, access to Pre-judging, Finals and Farewell Banquet and other amenities at the expenses of the Organizer. Part of this misrepresentation may be false claim that a person is an Athlete only to have that so-called Athlete fail to officially register as a competitor at the weigh-in or, once having officially registered, fail to compete. Any National Federation found guilty of misrepresentation will be immediately disqualified from the Championships and will be fined an amount equal to the Special Package Rate for each person involved.

Doping Controls:

Doping controls will be conducted by the IFBB Medical Commission pursuant to the IFBB Anti-Doping Rules, using a **WADA** accredited laboratory. In order to compete in the Championships, all competitors at the weigh-in and registration will be required to sign a Drug Testing Consent & Waiver of Liability Form. The IFBB reserves the rights to target test any athlete. The IFBB is signatory to the **WADA** Code. Participating National Federations have a duty and an obligation to ensure that their National Team Athletes are competing drug-free at the IFBB International Competitions.

Preliminary Entry Form:

The deadline date for the Preliminary Entry Form is **September 2nd**, **2019**. National Federations must return the Preliminary Entry Form to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible but not alter than deadline date, confirming your Federation intend to participate. If at this time you do not know the actual names of Official Participants (Athletes and Delegates, including Judges), please indicate the total number of individuals from your National Federation who will participate in the Championships.

Final Entry Form:

The deadline date for the Final Entry Form is **September 20**th, **2019**. National Federations must submit the actual names of all Official Participants (Athletes by category and Delegates, including Judges). You must also include your flight arrival and departure information. In order to guarantee hotel accommodations for your team, the Final Entry Form must be returned not later than the deadline

date.

Your cooperation is essential to ensuring your accommodations at the hotel and adequate transportation for your Team.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Minimum number of competitors to run a category should be 3. If less than 3 athletes, categories will be combined.

Pro Card Event:

The « 2019 IFBB South Pacific Oceania Championships » is an IFBB Elite Pro Card qualifier for Bodybuilding, Classic Physique, Men's Physique & Bikini Fitness categories. Each Overall / Open category winner in the above mentioned divisions will receive the IFBB Elite Pro Card (after application through his/her National Federation) and will be awarded with the USD \$500 prize money.

Awards

Top three athletes in each category will be awarded with medals. Top six athletes in each category will receive Certificate of Excellence.

Training Facility:

We have 2 sites for your training, one located at the Tahiti Pearl Beach Resort and the other is "The Gym Tahiti Centre" which is located just a few minutes into the town of Papeete. Free transportation for « The Gym Tahiti » is available.

Athlete and Delegate Entry to the Venue:

Each athlete and official delegate participating in the championship will be provided with a wristband, and this will need to be worn when entering the venue to ensure admittance. The wristbands will be distributed at the Registration and will allow athletes and officials to attend the Event for all day free of charge.

Posing Music:

All posing music must be supplied on a named audio CD or USB flash memory. To avoid confusion, there must be no other tracks on the CD or USB. The use of profane, vulgar and offensive language is strictly prohibited in the posing music.

Tanning Requirements:

The use of tans and bronzers that can be wiped off is not allowed. If the tan comes off by simply wiping, the athlete will not be allowed to enter the stage. Artificial body coloring and self-tanning products may be used provided that it is applied at least twenty-four hours prior to the Prejudging. Professional competition tanning methods (airbrush tanning, cabin spray tanning) may be used if applied by the professional companies and qualified personnel. Sparkles, glitter, shiny metallic pearls or gold coloring are prohibited whether applied as part of a tanning lotion or applied separately, regardless of who applied them on the competitor's body. Judges:

All National Federations are reminded that their nominations for judges must be also included in the Final Entry Forms according to the IFBB Rules. For more information, please contact:

IFBB International Judges must have a valid IFBB International Judge's Card with the IFBB yearly judges fee of EUR €50 (USD \$60) paid for 2019. All judges must be present at the Team Managers & Judges Meeting, which will start on October 04th at 16:00 at the Official Hotel.

Media Accreditation:

All media accreditation, except local media, shall be controlled by the IFBB Tahiti Magazine. All persons wishing to obtain media accreditation for this event must contact the Organizing Committee no later than September 20th, 2019.

Backstage Access:

Access to the backstage and/or dressing room areas shall be strictly limited to essential personnel only. Coaches and trainers who assist athletes in the dressing room area must be the same sex as the athlete they are assisting.

Early arrivals:

Any National Federations arriving **BEFORE** the Official Arrival Date of October 04^{th} , 2019 and staying on after the Official Departure Date of October 06^{th} , 2019 will be responsible for all their own expenses. They will also be responsible for their own transportation between the hotel and the airport. If you would like to stay additional days BEFORE or AFTER the Championships, please contact the Hotels cited. You are obliged to notify the Organizing Committee of your early arrivals and staying after October 5^{th} , 2019 no later than September 2^{nd} , 2019.
