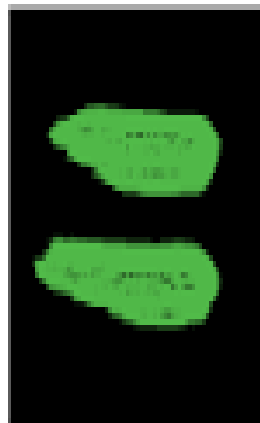
- **Fort Lauderdale–Hollywood International Airport** is a major public airport in Broward County, Florida, United States, and is one of three airports serving the Miami metropolitan area.
- This is the nearest airport to the Florida Classic with shuttles to the Embassy Suite Ft. Lauderdale 17<sup>th</sup> street.



# Miami International Airport



- A secondary option in terms of Proximity is the Miami International Airport. Miami International Airport (MIA), located on 3,230 acres of land near downtown Miami, is operated by the Miami-Dade Aviation Department and is the property of Miami-Dade County government.
- The distance from this airport to the Embassy Suites by Hilton Ft. Lauderdale 17<sup>th</sup> Street is 23.1 miles with a duration of 1hr 7min.

## Anti-Doping

- The 3<sup>rd</sup> Edition of the Florida Classic will be subject to the ADAMS System and the WADA Anti-Doping Rules. It is recommended that the participating National Federations carry out previous checks on these Championships to ensure that their athletes are free of Doping and thus avoid unnecessary fines and penalties.
- \*It is also the **FULL OBLIGATION AND RESPONSIBILITY** of a National Federation to **MONITOR ALL THE ATHLETES** affiliated to this National Federation who are fulfilling a period of ineligibility due to Anti- Doping Rule Violation or any Disciplinary case, to make sure these athletes **WILL NOT REGISTER/COMPETE/OR PARTICIPATE IN ANY CAPACITY** in any **EVENT** either at National or International level, Official or Invitational.

- Top six (6) athletes in each category will be awarded with a Certificate of Excellence and trophies.
- Overall winner will have a trophy

# Costs-

currency in U.S. Dollars

- All athletes should have a current National Federation Membership to their corresponding Federation. Costs will vary.
- IFBB International Passport- All athletes must present a current IFBB International Passport or purchase one at registration. \$45 usd
- Initial Registration: \$200 usd
- Crossover fee: \$100 usd per eligible crossover
- Late fee: \$50 after June 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022



# Tickets

- (For Unofficial Delegates and other Supporters)
- \$50 – All Day General Admission per seat. (Does not grant access backstage)
- \$100 – Backstage access Card (Limited Quantity)

- The Judges, coaches, trainers or supporters who are not official delegates will be responsible for the purchase of their own entry tickets.





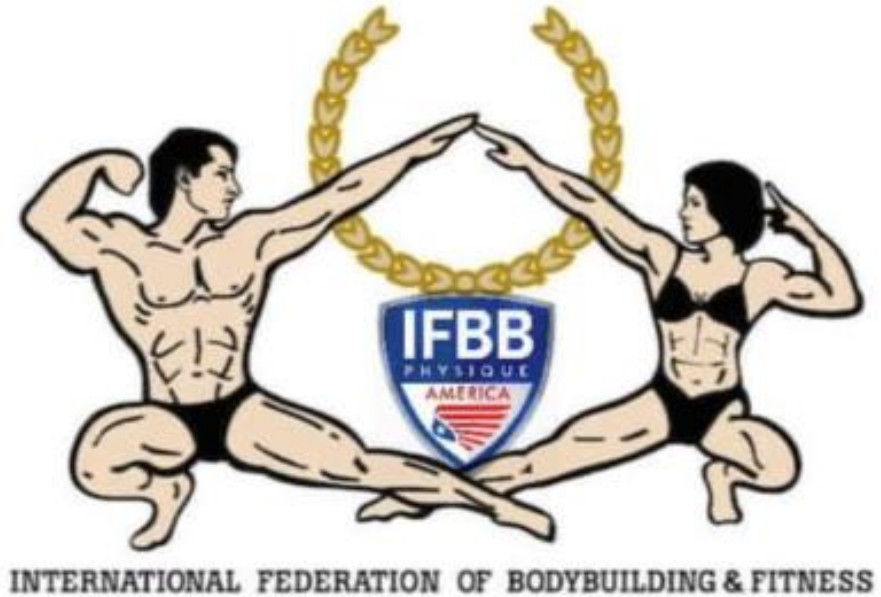
# Green Cards

- **For Official Delegates only- Green Cards are used to limit access to the weigh-in and backstage area during the prejudging and finals. They will be distributed at the judges/team managers meeting as follows:**
- **Five (5) athletes or more – two (2) cards**
- **Less than five (5) athletes- one (1) card.**

# Judges

- To be taken into consideration during selection of judges' panels at the competition, IFBB International Judges must be included in the Final Entry Forms sent by National Federations,

- All international judges must bring their International Judge's Cards to the Team Managers and Judges Meeting. IFBB International Judges must have a valid IFBB Judge's Card with the IFBB yearly judges fee of 60 \$ (USD) paid for the current year. This fee may also be paid at the EVENT at the Team Managers and Judges Meeting.





# Tanning, Hair and Make up Services

*We Spray*

- Tanning, hair and make-up services will be provided by WeSpray and may be booked online at <https://wespray.setmore.com/>.
- Tanning and Oil will only take place in the designated area by the Hotel. In compliance with venue rules, no cream or easily smeared tanning products may be used. To protect the venue, athletes are to remain dressed when not in the pump-up area or ready line while wearing tanning products.
- The IFBB has banned all tans that can be wiped off. An official will check the tan of all athletes backstage and if the tan comes off by simply wiping, the athlete will be told to remove the tan before going on stage.
- Violation of these rules are subject for immediate dismissal from the competition.

- Cameras and/or video tape equipment shall be strictly prohibited in the backstage and/or dressing room areas except when used by the IFBB authorized media person and, in any EVENT, these devices shall be strictly prohibited in the dressing room area.

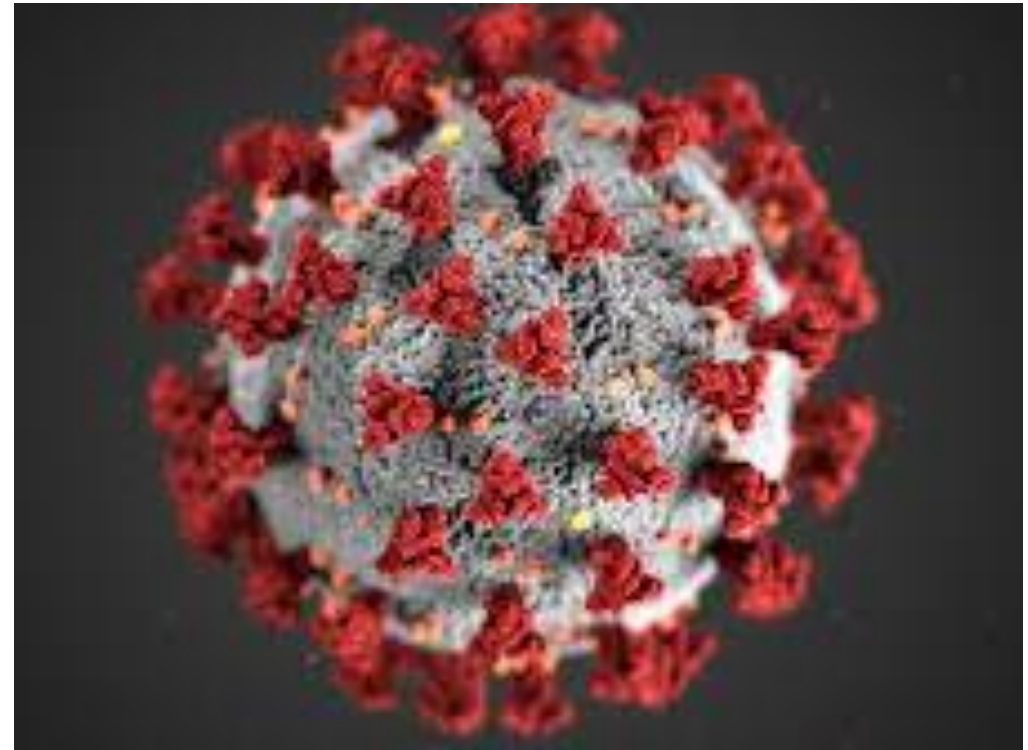

## Visas

**An Official Letter of Invitation will be made available if required. An athlete, included in an official National Federation team, who request and receive an invitation from the IFBB Head Office or the Organizing Committee of an IFBB sanctioned EVENT for visa purposes, and uses that visa to unlawfully stay in the host country or any other country, will be subjected to the disciplinary proceedings and measures. The relevant National Federation is responsible to carefully control the proper, legal use of the visa by his/her athlete and it will be subjected to a fine and/or a suspension, in case of any misuse and/or unlawful utilization of the same visa.**

# Covid-19

**Due to the COVID-19 situation, we recommend you check with the corresponding authorities of the country (Consulate, Embassy, etc.), the current regulation to avoid any inconveniences when travelling. The National Federations, athletes, and officials, must adopt and strictly follow any healthy and other measures imposed, required, or recommended by the competent authorities with respect to the COVID-19 pandemic situation.**
