



Located 15 miles north of Venezuela in the warm waters of the southern Caribbean, Aruba is home to beautiful white-sand beaches, 82-degree days, and some of the warmest people in the world. Aruba's rich, multicultural past is reflected in the, cuisine, architecture and the warm, friendly people. What began as a fishing outpost for Amerindians has changed hands between the Spanish and Dutch throughout the centuries, and is now a diverse constituent country of the Netherlands.

The Island is 19.6 miles long and 6 miles across, with a total area of 70 square miles. Located just below the hurricane belts, and unlike many of the other islands in the Caribbean, the climate is dry, so rarely does it rain. On the south and west coasts of Aruba, Oranjestad, the capital city, is located as well as miles of beaches which have been named the best in the Caribbean and the world.

The interior of the island is desert-like and it is where one will find Arikok National Park, a preserve with a variety of wildlife, cacti and dramatic rock formations and some of Aruba's most striking views, as the ocean crashes against the rugged shoreline. Along the he northeast coast and the windward shore, visitors will see the island's unofficial mascots, the Fofoti Tree. The constant trade winds have permanently sculpted them into graceful, southwesterly bending forms.

Currency: The currency in Aruba is Florins. US Dollars are widely accepted and it is not necessary to do currency exchange. Exchange rate for US dollars is Awg 1.77 for cash and Awg 1.78 for traveler's checks. (Awg 1.75 at supermarkets and gas stations / Awg 1.80 at shops and restaurants). Some shops will not accept US \$ 50 or US \$ 100 due to worldwide counterfeiting and generally may not able to give change in US currency but will do so with the local currency. All major credit cards and travelers checks are accepted.

ARUBA ENTRY & VISA REQUIREMENTS



For those countries requiring an Aruba entry visa (CACBBFF member countries Dominican Republic, Haiti, Jamaica, Venezuela) it is the responsibility of each respective Federation to make application and not the responsibility of the host federation in Aruba.

It is recommended to start the application process at least 8 weeks in advance as the processing of requests can take awhile to complete. **DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE.**

Other Requirements

- A valid return- or onward ticket;
- The necessary documents for returning to the country of origin or to a country that he/she has the right to enter, for example a valid residence permit (temporary or permanent), a re-entry permit or a (entry) visa;
- If so requested, any visitors may need to show proof of a valid reservation in name of each athlete for an accommodation in Aruba (e.g. hotel or apartment)
- If so requested, any visitor may need to show proof to the satisfaction of the migration officer of adequate financial means to provide for hotel expenses (if applicable) and living expenses during his/her stay or that he/she has a declaration of guarantee from a legal resident of Aruba.



Schengen country

If you hold a multiple-entry short-stay Schengen visa or residence permit for the Netherlands or another Schengen country, you do not need a visa.

Overseas France

If you hold a valid residence permit for (French) Guiana, Guadeloupe, Martinique, Mayotte, Réunion, Saint Barthélemy or Saint Martin, you do not require a visa.

United Kingdom or Ireland

If you hold a multiple-entry visa or residence permit for the United Kingdom or Ireland you do not need a visa.

<u>United States or Canada</u>

If you hold a residence permit for the United States or Canada, you do not need a visa.

If you hold a multiple-entry visa (this is not an ESTA) for the United States or Canada and are a national of the Dominican Republic, Haiti, Jamaica or Venezuela you do not need a visa.



The final authorization for admission to Aruba remains with the migration officer at the border-crossing/port of entry. The migration authorities at the border- crossing/port of entry have the authority to grant or refuse admission. Admission can be refused if not all admission requirements are fulfilled by the time of entering Aruba or if a visitor has been blacklisted. Holding a valid visa does not guarantee entry into Aruba.

All National Federations may request for an invitation letter from the CAC Organizing committee. This invitation letter does not mean you are granted your visa. Please note that application for visas will need to be made with the nearest Consulate of The Netherlands and should be made no less than 8 weeks in advance at a minimum

The CAC organizing committee is not responsible for participants' visa requests or approvals

Any athlete who requested and received an invitation letter from the host organizing committee for visa purposes and uses this visa to unlawfully stay in Aruba or is involved in any illegal activity or possession of illegal drugs/supplements upon arrival or departure will be subject to Aruba's disciplinary proceedings and measures. Any costs associated with any such measures is the responsibility of the individual and his / her National Federation and NOT the responsibility of the host organizing committee.

YELLOW FEVER VACCINE

At the suggestion and guidelines of the World Health Organization and the International Health Regulations, the Ministry of Health of Aruba established that, **as of March 1, 2018**, the requirement for the Yellow Fever Vaccine proven by an International Certificate of Vaccination or Prophylaxis (ICVP), also known as the Yellow Book, will enter into force for all passengers entering the island from endemic areas. For this reason, we would like to communicate the following:

The vaccine is MANDATORY for all passengers arriving from the Central American, Latin American and African (high risk) countries: Bolivia, Peru, Ecuador, Colombia, Brazil, Venezuela, Paraguay, Panama, French Guiana, Guyana, Suriname, Trinidad and Tobago.

In order to be valid, the vaccine must be applied at least 10 days before the trip. That is, visitors must be vaccinated at least 10 days before entering the island territory. It is important to keep in mind that if the passenger has been vaccinated before, even if it has been more than 10 years, and still keeps his yellow fever vaccination document (ICVP), he should not be re-vaccinated. Similarly, if the visitor has lost his or her certificate of vaccination, he / she must re-vaccinate. The latter of which does not entail any additional risk of side effects.

- -The yellow book (ICVP) must be presented to the immigration officers of the Department of Immigration, Security and Alarm of Aruba (IASA).
- -Visitors who were born in areas classified as high risk for Yellow Fever transmission, but live in Europe and the United States and travel to Aruba, do not need to get the vaccine or present the yellow book.
- -Passengers who reside in Europe or the United States and travel from countries classified as high risk to Aruba do need to be vaccinated and present the yellow book.

Except for:

Passengers who have been in countries at risk and are in transit through Aruba. This also includes those who have to leave and re-enter the airport or cruise ships in less than 24 hours.

Passengers on their way to Aruba who have been in transit through countries at risk (in their airports and ports). Passengers who, having been in the countries considered at risk, before entering Aruba have remained for a period of at least 6 days in a country that is not considered at risk and have not developed fever during that period.



ARRIVALS

All delegations are asked and encouraged to arrive no later than Thursday, September 21, 2023. The official airport of Aruba is the Queen Beatrix International Airport. https://www.airportaruba.com

EMBARKATION CARD (ED Card)

All arrivals must submit their on-line immigration ED card within 7 days **PRIOR** to arrival. Upon submission, an email message will be received with a GREEN checkmark indicating initial approval to enter Aruba. It is recommended to download a photo of the approval checkmark. This approval will be requested by the airline upon check-in and upon boarding the aircraft. **BE SURE TO SUBMIT IN ADVANCE OF TRAVEL**


ACCOMMODATIONS & EXPENSES

ELIGIBILITY

All participating national federations must be members affiliated with the IFBB & CACBBFF. Federations must be current with the payment of their annual affiliation fees to the IFBB and CACBBFF. It is recommended that each federation verify with the CACBBFF Treasurer to confirm their membership status to avoid any disqualification of any athletes from competition. The limit of participants for any country is 40 athletes

OFFICIAL ATHLETE REGISTRATION

Registration and weigh is scheduled for Friday, September 22, 2023 from 9:00 am - 3:30 pm. All competing athletes must be members in good standing of their national Federations and nominated by their National Federation by sending the Final Entry form


All competing athletes must present their Passports and IFBB International Cards upon Registration. This IFBB card is mandatory for all athletes. The fee for purchase or renewal of the IFBB International Card is \$50

The inscription fee per athlete is US \$100 to be paid upon registration. If an athlete wants to participate in any additional category (crossover) for which he / she is eligible, the registration fee is an additional US \$50 per category.

ANTI-DOPING

The 50th Central American and Caribbean Championships will be subject to the ADAMS system and the WADA Anti-Doping Rules to be administered and controlled by the CACBBFF Doping Commission.

It is recommended that each participating National Federation carry out their own verification with their athletes to ensure that their athletes are free of any banned substance to avoid any sanctions, fines and penalties



POSING MUSIC

All music must be presented on a USB stick. The USB must have ONLY the music to be used for posing. USB sticks containing more than one song cannot be accepted. It is recommended that each athlete present 2 USB memories in case of any technical problem

For easy identification, each competitor must place his / her name and country name on the USB stick

Competitors participating in two classes must bring 2 USB Drives, one for each class if they contain different music

Athletes or federation representatives must pick up all music at the conclusion of the event or athlete's category. The Organizing Committee will not be responsible for any music that is not collected.

The use of profane, vulgar and offensive language is strictly prohibited in the posing music.

TANNING

The IFBB has banned all tans that can be wiped off. An official will check the tan of all athletes backstage and if the tan comes off by simply wiping, the athlete will be told to remove the tan before going on stage.

A Tanning service with Pro-Tan Aruba is made available to athletes. Packages and pricing will be provided. Online booking will be available as of July 31, 2023.

JUDGES

To assist the Judges Committee in the selection of judges for the different judging panels for the CAC Championships, each Federation must provide names in advance of each participating certified judge along with those individuals who wish to participate as a "test" judge.

All names of the judges should be submitted to the CACBBFF, the Aruba Bodybuilding & Powerlifting Association and its Organizing Committee as part of the Final Entry Form submission. These will be considered with priority.

The annual fee for renewal of Continental Judges passport is \$30. This fee must be paid to the CAC Treasurer.

All International IFBB judges must have a valid and current IFBB judges passport having paid the annual IFBB judge fee of 50 euros for the year 2023. This fee can also be paid at championships in the Aruba. Please add the names of the judges and test judges on the final registration form.

A judges seminar / meeting is tentatively scheduled for 9:00 am Saturday, September 23



NATIONAL FLAG

All participating National Federations must bring a National Flags to be used during the awards ceremonies for those athletes winning 1st place in his/her category. The recommended size is 5 feet by 3 feet (150 cm x 90 cm)

NATIONAL ANTHEM

All participating National Federations must bring music of their National Anthem on a USB. This must be on a separate CD from any posing music (The anthem must be a short version with a max of 35 seconds)

NATIONAL UNIFORMS


A maximum of two, non repetitive, sponsors' names are allowed on National Uniforms (names of liquor and tobacco products, as well as substances declared to be prohibited by WADA Fitness are not permitted). Athletes are allowed to have only one sponsor's name. Names should not exceed 5 inches by three 3 inches (12.7 cm by 7.6 cm)

PARADE OF NATIONS

All delegates are reminded that the dress code for the Parade of Nations is the official IFBB uniform The dress code for all athletes taking part in the Parade of Nations is their posing attire. One (1) delegate and one (1) competitor per country must take part in the Parade of Nations which is scheduled is scheduled for Sunday, September 24, 2023



PRELIMINARY ENTRY FORMS

National Federations are required to notify the Organizing Committee in Aruba of their intention to participate by submitting the Preliminary Entry Form no later than July 31, 2023. The Form must include the estimated number of athletes, delegates, additional delegates and accompanying persons.

FINAL ENTRY FORMS

Final Entry Forms of participation must be submitted by September 14, 2023. This includes all arrival and departure information, names, divisions, bodyweight or height categories, and passport numbers of all participating athletes, names and passport numbers of their delegates, IFBB judges, test judges and any accompanying persons, The accurate and timely presentation of this information is essential for the Aruba Bodybuilding & Powerlifting Association and its Organizing Committee to ensure adequate transportation for each delegation.

SECRETARIAT

The Aruba Organizing Committee and the CACBBFF, will establish a secretariat at the Eagle Resort and / or the Marriott Resort.

The Secretariat will run from Wednesday, September 21 to Sunday, September 2
